In this position he has the unique privilege of working with many types of photographic media; aerial, color, movie, still, black and white, documentary, promotional, instructional and many others. He also makes extensive use of planes and helicopters to carry out his assignments.

This is your opportunity to hear a "working photographer" discuss his equipment and how he makes it work for him.

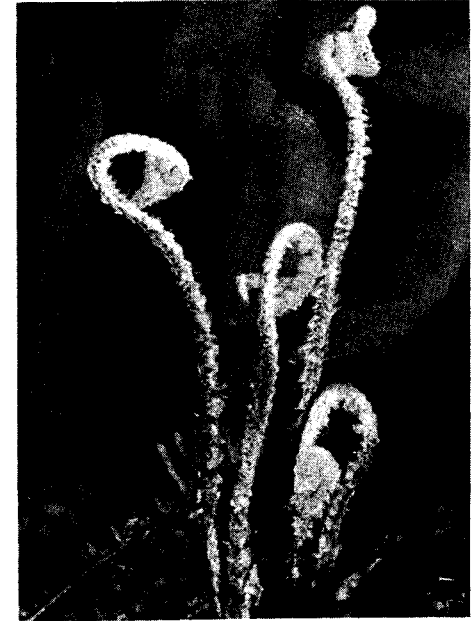
