

The regular monthly meeting of the Photographic Society of Chattanooga will be held on Thursday, April 8, 1965 at 7:45 PM at the Northside Branch, Hamilton National Bank.

Mr. Walter Cline, Jr., President, W. M. Cline Co. of Chattanooga, will present "Slides of Leningrad, Moscow, and Mountain Climbing in Switzerland". In 1964, Mr. Cline traveled on a photographic industry People-to-People tour of Europe, including in his itinerary several "Behind the Iron Curtain" countries. Also visited were the swiss Alps, and Mr. Cline, together with his mountain climbing guide, Hieronymus Inderbiner, explored several peaks in the area of Zermatt, Switzerland with climbs to the Breithorn, Lenspitze and Rifflehorn - culminating in the 14,700 foot climb to the very summit of the Matterhorn - a day and a half was required to conquer the peak.

Mr. Cline is a fine professional photographer and his illustrated lecture is an exceptionally moving program of excitement, beauty, and current interest.

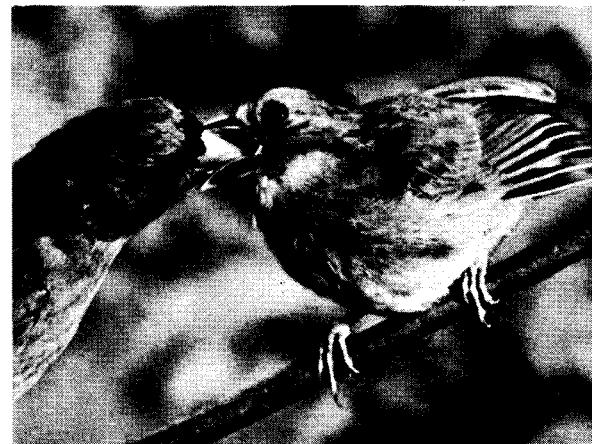
