RULES
PRINT AND SLIDE OF YEAR CONTEST
FOR 1967 ENTRIES

1. Any P. S. of C Member in good standing is eligible to participate in the Annual Print and Slide of Year Contest.
2. Picture has to be made by contestant, although processing and finishing may be done by someone other than the photographer.
3. Prints or slides that have been entered in previous Print & Slide of Year Contests conducted by the P.S. of C. are not eligible.
4. Each contestant will be allowed four entries in each of the three divisions.
5. All entries will be assigned a master number for each contestant, along with an alphabet letter, in order to identify the entry. Put your name on the back side of each print or slide.
6. Black and White Prints (4) must be mounted on 16 x 20 Salon Boards, maximum size 11 x 14, minimum size 8 x 10, no hand painted or tinted prints are eligible. Toning by direct photographic methods are eligible.
7. Color Prints (4) must be mounted on 16 x 20 Salon Boards, maximum size 8 x 10, minimum size 5 x 7.
8. Color Slides (4) may be 35 MM, Super Slides or 2½ x 2½ slides are eligible, any type mount is permissible. All slides should be marked for projection with a big dot on the lower left corner when viewed in an upright position.
9. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES WILL BE NOVEMBER 4, 1967, AT 12 NOON. ENTRIES MAY BE LEFT AT VIOLET CAMERA SHOP AT No. 9 East 7th Street or THE CAMERA CENTER at No. 13 West 8th Street.
10. All entries may be returned to the contestant after the Christmas Party; however, those that are not picked up there will be returned to Camera Center, No. 13 West 8th Street, and the responsibility for picking up the entries will be on the contestant.
11. The P. S. of C. will exercise the utmost care in the handling of the entries but does not assume responsibility in case of loss or damage to the prints or slides.
12. The contest will be handled by out of town judges appointed by the Photographic Society of America. Their decisions will be final.
