ANNUAL PRINT AND SLIDE OF YEAR CONTEST

1970

1. The contest is open to all members of P. S. C., in good standing.
2. Entries in previous year contest (Annual Print and Slide) are not eligible, those so recognized will be disqualified.
3. All entries must have the contributor's name and address on them.
4. The original negative or transparency must have been taken by the contributor, finishing may be by others.
5. Prints submitted must be no larger than 11 x 14, nor smaller than 8 x 10, mounted on 16 x 20 salon mounts. Prints may be vertical or horizontal format.
6. Slides may be 2 x 2 or 2 $\frac{1}{4}$  x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$  suitably mounted for projection. Cardboard, plastic, metal or glass mounted will be accepted. Slides should be properly marked for projection, mark in lower left corner.
7. Hand-tinted prints are not eligible, toning by photographic processes is permitted.
8. There will be three divisions, each contestant will be allowed four entries in each division. Divisions are listed below.
  - (a) Monochrome Prints (Black & White)
  - (b) Color Prints
  - (c) Color Slides (2 x 2) (2 $\frac{1}{4}$  x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ )
9. Prints and Slides will be shipped to out-of-town judges appointed by the Photographic Society of America - Their decisions will be final.
10. Ribbons will be awarded to the top five entries in each division, with Plaques awarded to the first place winners in each division.
11. Entries may be left at Camera Center - 13 West Eighth Street, Violet Camera Shop - 8 East Seventh Street, or delivered to any member of the Contest Committee. Closing date for submitting entries is October 31, 1970.
12. Awards will be given at our Annual Christmas Party in December.
13. The Committee will exercise all care possible, but, the P. S. of C. nor the committee will be responsible for damage to entries.
14. Entries may be picked up after the Christmas Party, otherwise they will be returned to receiving point and the responsibility of pick-up will be the contestant's.
